Wellness Care

The following procedures and examinations may be conducted to establish a baseline of your pet's health. This baseline is then used to help monitor the wellness of your pet throughout his or her lifetime.

- Wellness exam
- Blood panel
- Blood pressure screening
- Electrocardiograms (ECG)
- Glaucoma exam
- Heartworm testing
- Hormone level testing
- Internal parasite testing
- Lyme testing
- Urinalysis
