LASER Therapy FAQs

Q: How does a [therapeutic laser](#) work?

A: It has a biochemical and photochemical effect on the cells. These photons stimulate each individual cell to revitalize and reactivate its own healing processes through a biochemical cascade of events.

Q: Will the LASER therapy hurt my pet?

A: No, there is no pain involved and no anesthetic is required.

Your pet only feels a warm sensation that most find relaxing.

Q: How soon will I see my pet feel some relief?

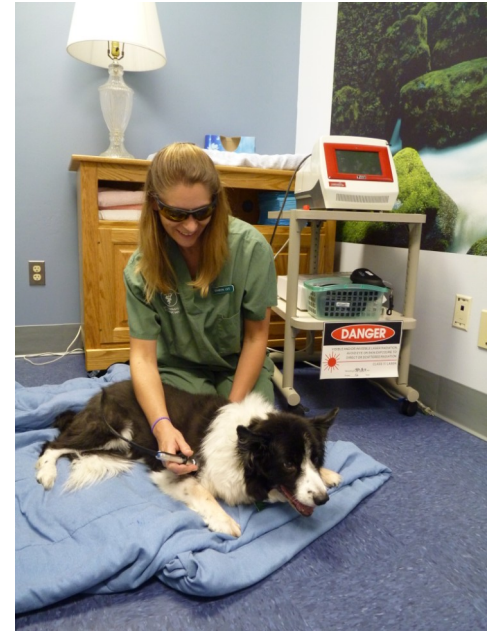
A: Response varies but most see a difference after only a few treatments.

Q: How long are the sessions?

A: The therapy sessions range from a few minutes to an hour depending on the area(s) being treated. They are performed in our quiet and comfortable LASER room.

Beneficial Effects Of LASER Therapy

- 1. Reduces pain.**
